

**SPECIAL MEETING OF THE DASSEL CITY COUNCIL
AUGUST 16, 2017, 6:05 P.M.
CITY HALL**

The special meeting of the Dassel City Council was called to order by Mayor Hungerford at 6:05 p.m. on August 16, 2017 at Dassel City Hall.

Present: Council members Bemenderfer, Carlson, Hallquist and Mayor Hungerford (4)
Absent: Council member Weseloh (1)

The purpose of the meeting was to review the 2018 proposed general fund levy.

Clerk Boese presented the 2018 proposed levy information which included a 4% general fund levy increase and the proposed general fund budget. The council reviewed the reports presented and Mayor Hungerford explained his recommendation for a 4% increase in the levy.

Council member Weseloh arrived at 6:50 p.m.

Boese will review the proposed refunds & reimbursements line items for additional clarification. The proposed budgeted revenues are \$1,027,155 and expenditures \$1,026,691. The proposed levy is \$713,376.

After much discussion in regard to individual departmental budgets, the council directed Clerk Boese to add the proposed levy to the next regular agenda for approval.

The council also discussed water and sewer rates, repairs needed and the capital improvement plan that will be presented at a study session in the near future.

Motion by Bemenderfer, seconded by Carlson to adjourn the meeting at 8:37 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
