EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE DASSEL CITY COUNCIL MARCH 17, 2020 6:00 P.M. DASSEL CITY HALL

The emergency meeting of the Dassel City Council was called to order by Mayor Hungerford at 6:00 p.m. on March 17, 2020 at Dassel City Hall.

Present: Council members Carlson, Hallquist, Weseloh and Mayor Hungerford (4) Absent: Council member Hollaran (1)

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss community options in regard to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Council reviewed recommendations from the League of MN Cities, CDC and the staff.

Motion by Carlson, seconded by Hallquist to adopt Resolution 2020-009 Declaring a Community Health Emergency Regarding COVID-19. Motion carried.

Motion by Carlson, seconded by Weseloh to approve the Community Health Emergency Plan with changes to Phase 1 & 2. Motion carried.

The Council reviewed Department Head recommendations for handling the initial phases of the plan and it was agreed to close the following building to the public beginning Wednesday, March 18 until May 1, 2020: City Hall, History Center and Public Works. The Liquor Store will remain open at this time. Staff at the Liquor Store will take additional precautions to keep themselves and the public safe. The Council discussed several ways to meet remotely, if necessary, during the continued health emergency. Meeting options include telephonic or other electronic means as provided in MN Statute 13D.021.

The City Clerk will notify members of the City's National Incident Management Board: Debbie Morris, DC School; Brianne Wolters, Lakeside Health Care Facility; and Meeker County Sheriff, Brian Cruze of the actions taken at this meeting.

Motion by Carlson, seconded by Weseloh to adjourn the meeting at 7:40 p.m. Motion carried.
